Three pronged approach for the Business Case

Short Term – energy efficiency via Community Shed, planning and fund raising (audits, information, education, advice and referral)

Medium Term – energy improvements via partnerships, planning, fundraising and governance (bulk buying, assisting with affordability etc.)

Long Term – local generation at scale via planning, fundraising and a suitable governance structure

These three types of energy services are being developed in parallel with Stake Holders require individual business plans.

In Mirboo North 20% of Homes and Businesses have connected to Solar Electricity and Hot Water (150 connections) That's about \$2m investment generating approximately 1MWh and saving 2000 tonnes of Co2
